Low Income Senior or Disability Discount Information

The Co-op's objective is providing a limited senior/disability discount is to assist those who really need it while also providing the lowest prices possible for all shoppers. Since only those who need the discount apply, we are able to reduce prices for everyone on basic foods throughout the store with our expanded Co-op Basic Pricing Program.

Details of the Co-op Low Income Senior or Disability Discount Policy:

- The senior and disability discounts are only for owners who complete the application process outlined below and on the application form itself
- The senior discount is intended for those owners on a limited income who would experience economic hardship if they did not receive the discount. We ask that you do not apply if you don't really need the discount. The savings will go towards lower prices that will serve all shoppers
- The 5% senior discount is currently available before 11am everyday, and all day Wednesdays and Sundays
- The age requirement for the senior discount is 65
- The discount is available to households, only if the principal owner of the account qualifies for the Low Income Senior or Disability discount
- The 5% disability discount is separate and is currently offered all day, 7 days a week to those owners with disabilities that apply. Proof of disability, such as receiving Social Security Disability, SSI, Veterans, or State Disability benefits is required. A Handicap parking placard is not proof of disability
